GENERAL INFORMATION

The Carbon Group of the Institute of Physics of the Nicholas Copernicus University (NCU) is organising 7th Torunian Carbon Symposium in a co-operation with the Polish Graphite Society.

The Symposium will be held at the Institute of Physics of the NCU in Toruń. Both the surroundings of the old town and scientific character of the University ensure a closed-circle atmosphere of the Symposium, and the possibility of a creative rest.

Members of the Symposium will be registered in the Institute of Physics of the NCU, Grudziądzka Street 5/7, Toruń.

FORMS OF PRESENTATION

Organisers allow for three forms of presentation:

- a) 30-minute lecture (+10 min. for discussion),
 - b) 15-minute lecture (+5 min. for discussion),
 - c) posters (the size of the posters should not exceed 100 cm x 80 cm)
- Organisers ask for information if any technical equipment, except projector for transparency, will be needed. Please inform us as quickly as possible (via e-mail, fax or telephone).

CONFERENCE FEE

The cost of participation in the Symposium has been finally calculated as follows:

- 600 zł – participants (550 zł if paid till the end of July),
 - 500 zł – members of Polish Graphite Society (500 zł if paid till the end of July),
 - 450 zł – students accompanying their supervisor (400 zł if paid till the end of July),
 - 250 zł – accompanying persons (200 zł if paid till the end of July)
- Free – invited speakers & honor guests

The fee does not cover costs of accommodation (and breakfasts). Conference fee covers abstract book and conference materials, meals (without breakfasts which are served in hotels, **hotel is not included**) and all additional attractions.
